LYNNFIELD — The Library Building Committee is currently seeking Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) from firms to provide services as the Owner's Project Manager (OPM) for the planning and design of a renovated or new public library.

The building committee is seeking these bids on behalf of the town for OPM services that would commence immediately after the contract award. Bid documents became available May 13, at Town Hall, 55 Salem St., from the Office of the Board of Selectmen or by sending an e-mail to Town Administrator Jim Boudreau at jbou-

The planning and design of the library is expected to be completed by June 30, 2016.
