All storytimes are open to the public - no registration required

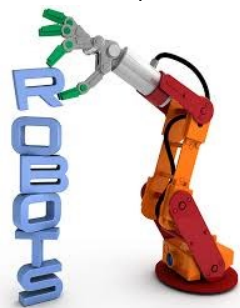

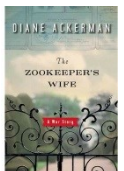
